

Map guide: Wind

The map displays symbols representing real-time data recorded by wind gauges throughout the region.

Wind: average wind speed over the last 10 minutes at 10 metres above ground level: the colour of the symbol

indicating the station shows the intensity expressed in metres per second (m/s), while the 'beards'

indicate the average hourly speed expressed in knots, and the direction of the bar indicates the direction of

origin. To estimate wind strength and its effects on land and sea, you can also consult the Beaufort scale.

The following is available for each station:

- data on the map for the previous two days, with the symbols described above
- a graph of wind trends for the previous two days and the current day, shown with the same symbols
- station details (basin, sub-basin, altitude above sea level)
